When the Great Pyramid was built as

atomb for an Egyptian ruler around 2560 BG, it was easily

the tallest man-made structure in the world

at 431 feet high. Meanly 4,000 years later,

fit was STILL the world's tallest structure, until the completion of England's Lincoln Cathedral, which

reached 525 feet into the sky in 1911. When the Washington Monument became the world's tallest at 555 feet more than 500 years later in 1834, it was still only about 100 feet taller than the Great Promid at Giza.
